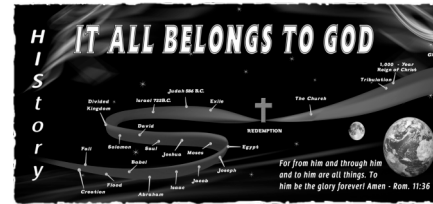

The Divided Kingdom

Kingdom splits – 1 Kings 12:1 – 16 (v.16)

Northern kingdom is known as *Israel* – 10 tribes join Jeroboam

The southern kingdom is called *Judah* – 2 tribes, Judah and Benjamin stay with Rehoboam and the house of David
