

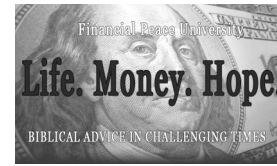

2. Don't _____ money.

"No one can serve two masters. You'll be devoted to one and despise the other. You can't serve both God and money." Luke 16:13

3. Don't _____ money

"Tell those who are rich in this world not to be proud and not to trust in their money which will soon be gone. Their trust should be in the living God who richly gives us all we need for our enjoyment." 1 Timothy 6:17
